Guidelines for Participants

{Registration mandatory for any event}

Mention of guide, co guide or institution is not allowed. The accepted abstracts will have a unique identification code which should be displayed in the poster, paper, and video presentations.

All post graduates participating should be present with bonafide certificate from the institution at the time of registration.

All abstracts should reach on or before 20th march 2018.

DVDs for video presentations should reach on or before 10th April 2018

Acceptance of participation to compete is subject to decision of scientific committee

All communications to the participants will be only through email or whatsapp

Scientific Oral Paper presentation:

The presentation can have only one author.

Two paper presentations are allowed s from each institution.

The paper presentation should be only in power-point of the standard format

The presenter should upload the presentation in their allotted halls at 8:30 to 10:30am on Day 1, 28th April 2017. No modification after uploading the presentation. All presentations should be made compatible with MS Office 2007.

The presenter should fill the abstract of the paper in narrative format with 2 to 3 key words in the form attached [Abstract submission form] Times new roman; 12 font size;1.5 line spacing; not exceeding 250 words

The participants can introduce themselves with their personal identity. No mention of the institution should be made verbally or non-verbally during their presentation.

The presentation time is 8 minutes only with 2 minutes for discussion.

Scientific Poster presentation:

The poster should have 2 authors.

No limit on the number of entries from the institution.

The poster should be only in hard copy with 3'width and 4'length in a portrait format.

The minimum font size should be readable from 4 feet distance.

The poster should be descriptive and self-explanatory. Necessary explanation will be asked optionally by the judges.

Any of the authors[s] may be asked to present the poster.

The duration of the poster presentation should be not more than 5 minutes.

Clinical/Laboratory Demonstration Video:

The video presentation can have a maximum of three authors.

No limit in the number of participations from the institution.

The video should be not more than 10 minutes

The video should have a resolution of at least 480p and should be made compatible to be viewed with vlc/mp3/windows media player.

The video needs to be supported by explanatory short captions not more than 2 lines each which should have a readable contrast with the background.

No audio accompaniment is allowed.

The Video should be recorded in a DVD and sent along with the abstract form attached to the postal address mentioned.

Mention the Unique identification number in the footage of the video and also in the Disc Cover along with the title and only the names of the authors.

Prostho Quiz:

The theme for the quiz would be on recent advancements in prosthodontics.

The quiz participation is by a team of three.

No limit on the number of teams from an institution. A screening round will be present if the number of teams exceed 5.

The quiz masters decision is final.

Best Post Graduate award by TNIPS:

No limit on the number of participants from an institution.

A Screening round will select the first 5 post graduates based on the performance in an objective examination which will be conducted on Day -1 of the conference at 12:30pm to 2:00pm.

The selected 5 post graduates have to upload their presentation on Day 1 4:00pm and submit a one page summary of their curricular [academic, clinical, research, publications] credentials and their involvement and achievements in co- curricular events like conferences with supporting documents which will be scrutinized and verified.

The next round will be presentation by the post graduate, on Day-2 of the conference at 11:30am to 1:00pm of their best cases to a panel of judges who would evaluate and inquire.

The decision would be made by the judges based on meticulous treatment planning, details of documentation, presentation and answering skills.

Violating any of the instructions mentioned above will disqualify the entry.

Prizes will be awarded with certificate for each event. Winning trophy will be given for the best post graduate of the year.
