CRITERIA FOR A CANDIDATE TO WIN MEDAL AT UNIVERSITY CONVOCATION

(AS AMENDED IN 2019)

UNDERGRADUATE COURSES

YEAR WISE MEDALS

- First attempt pass in all subjects in that particular year
- Greater than or equal to 65% aggregate in the year and being the topper.

OVERALL MEDAL

- First attempt pass in all subjects for the entire course period.
- Greater than or equal to 65% aggregate and being the topper for the entire course period.

NOTE: If more than one candidate, scores identical marks for the topper for year wise or overall medal, then the medal will be shared and all the candidates will be receiving the medal. The cost of the medals will be shared from the amount that accrues from the interest of that Endowment concerned.

POSTGRADUATE COURSES

- First attempt pass in all the subjects of the discipline.
- Greater than or equal to 60% aggregate and being the topper in the discipline concerned.

NOTE: If more than one candidate, scores identical marks for the topper for the medal in the discipline concerned, then the concerned medal will be shared and all the candidates will be receiving the medal. The cost of the medals will be shared from the amount that accrues from the interest of that Endowment concerned.

If one candidate only has appeared at the University examination, then the criteria for considering for the medal will be first attempt pass in all the subjects concerned and the candidate should have scored an aggregate equal to or more than 60%.
