INTRODUCING SRI BALAJI VIDYAPEETH

Young, Modern & Marching Ahead

- Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth (SBV) is a young deemed University, proud of its modernity, yet firmly grounded in rich educational heritage.
- SBV aims to excel in academic and clinical medicine; research and training; nurturing passion and enthusiasm into achievement and converting theoretical knowledge into evidence based practice and research.
- SBV was granted 'Deemed University' status by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 3 of the UGC Act of 1956 in 2008, in recognition of its outstanding quality of providing education, potential for excellence and obtained NAAC 'A' Grade in 2015, with CGPA of 3.11 on 4 point scale.
- SBV has been placed in the top 100 for three consecutive years 2016, 2017 & 2018 at the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) and is in the top 25 among the Medical colleges through its flagship institute, namely Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute.
- SBV(DU) thus enjoys complete autonomy to develop and implement innovative curriculum and academic programs and to design its own education process that is responsive and tailored to the evolving needs and changes of health sciences.
- The Deemed University's constituent colleges and courses are all duly accredited and recognised by the respective statutory bodies such as the Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India and the Indian Nursing Council. - SBV(DU) is a research oriented university and the establishment of state-of-the-art Central Interdisciplinary Research Facility pledges considerable resources and investment for Biomedical Research.

- SBV is governed by an enlightened collegium of eminent scholars, clinicians and scientists, headed ably by our visionary Chairman and Chancellor, Shri. M. K. Rajagopalan; Vice-Chancellor Prof.ESC.Parija, a well recognised medical educationist; Renowned teacher, Prof.N.Ananthakrishnan, Dean of Faculty & Allied Health Sciences; Prof. M. Ravishankar, Dean, Faculty of Medicine, providing leadership and stewardship towards excellence.

The genesis of Faculty Development in Health Professions Education

Faculty Development Programs (FDP) are the corner stone for the successful functioning of a Health Sciences University. On one hand, they prepare the faculty for delivering their job responsibility as teachers, clinicians, researchers, administrators and leaders. FDPs are instrumental for ensuring their career enhancement in each of the domains of functioning. More importantly, the FDPs contribute to the quality assurance provided by an institute and hence in its accreditation process. The Health Sciences Universities today, are facing the challenges of achieving the accreditation and rankings by the regulatory authorities. The accreditation goes a long way in establishing the credibility of an institute in terms of employability of their products in a global competition. Capacity building, skilling, and competency development are the new buzz words. Faculty development is the spring board for launching curricular reforms and bringing about quality enhancement in education, patient care or research.

There is no doubt that a large number of workshops, conferences and CME activities are being organized in our country by various medical, dental, nursing and allied health sciences universities. However, what is lacking is a concerted effort to bring FDP by combining the efforts made by individual institutes. Such an effort can only bring synergy in to the system and can make an impact on the system.

Secondly, the existing approaches to FDP focus more on quantity rather than quality. This is partly because of lack of expertise available locally, and the high cost of outsourcing the experts from far away places. Thirdly, the existing programs are not financially sustainable on a long term basis, when the cost involved in conducting FDP, cannot guarantee matching return of investment (ROI) in spite of sporadic funding from various agencies. Last but not the least, the existing approach to FDP is largely limited to single department or discipline. This can not ensure 'interprofessional approach' to capacity building which is vital for the successful delivery of health care amidst growing specialization resulting in acute compartmentalization.

Hence the efforts to revamp FDP should be seen as a collective exercise by several individuals and agencies who can function as Knowledge Partners. Networking is not only desirable, but also essential in a competitive world to bring transformative learning, which is the goal of all faculty development. This philosophy prompted Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth a forerunner in health sciences education, patient care and research to come out with a unique model of FDP, in collaboration with external knowledge partners, perhaps for the first time in the history of Health Sciences Universities in India.

About Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth (SBV)

Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth (SBV) is a Health Sciences Deemed to be University accredited by NAAC with A Grade. SBV is one among the top 100 Universities in India, as per India Rankings 2019 published by NIRF (Ministry of Human Resources, Government of India). At any given timeline, SBV would have nearly four thousand students pursuing various courses in the four constituent colleges (MGMCRI, SSSMCRI, IGIDS and KGNC), seven centres (CIDRF, CHPE, MSC, CMTER, CYTER, CAReTS, ASTRA Cadaver Lab) besides faculty of Medicine, Dentistry, Nursing, Allied Health Sciences, Physiotherapy and Pharmacy.

The vision of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth is to be a premier global Health Science University engaged in promoting innovations in education, providing health care of the highest standards, fostering research in the advancing frontiers of medicine and related sciences including complementary therapy for the benefit of the society.

This drives the mission of SBV to create innovative ecosystem that facilitates the development of health care professionals. The mission also underlines capacity building of health care professionals in broader perspective of integrating education, patient care and research.

Centre for Health Professions Education(CHPE)

The Centre for Health Professions Education (CHPE) was established by SBV in 2015 to work towards the goal of attaining excellence in health professions education in alignment with the mission of SBV to promote capacity building of health personnel in a holistic manner. This is being pursued by the centre by launching new innovative programs based on Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) recommended by the UGC, which are available and accessible to teachers across the profession, working in medical, dental, nursing and allied health sciences disciplines. Another major area of focus has been Faculty Development which is the corner stone for ensuring the success of curricular reforms as well as career enhancement of the faculty.

About the Academy of Health Professions Educators (AHPE)

The Academy of Health Professions Educators (AHPE) is a non-profitable organization working for the academic development of faculty across health profession in India. It has completed six years of its existence dedicated to the quality and relevance of health professions education. The Academy has played key role in policy making and implementation of new MBBS curriculum of MCI now under National Medical Commission. Another key area of interest is faculty development. AHPE is keen to promote collaborations among and outside health professions that have both, local and global dimensions. Besides conducting webinars on thrust areas it also provides a window to the world of health professions education through its annual National Conference of the Health Professions Educators (NCHPE). The NCHPE 2019 was organized by KLE Academy of Higher Education and Research (KAHER) University's, Jawaharlal Nehru Medical college at Belagavi from 21- 23 November 2019. The theme of the conference was "Competency Based Medical Education: Transformative Learning: From Theory to Practice".

Having made its presence felt in the national scenario, AHPE has come forward to enter in to a collaborative venture with Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, as a knowledge partner for launching National faculty development program.

The National Faculty Development Program launched by SBV

- SBV by virtue of presence of all health professions institutes (Medical, Dental, Nursing and Allied Health science) under one single campus is uniquely placed to offer a wide range of Faculty Development Programs across the health professions. By collaborating with AHPE as a knowledge partner, it is possible to bring high quality and value to the FDPs. This is achieved by commissioning a core group of educators from the constituent colleges of SBV, who work as Coordinators. Being coached, mentored and hand-held by national experts they can deliver a continuous stream of workshops round the year. This arrangement will help in deriving multiple benefits. It will stimulate local capacity building. Further, it will serve as a stepping stone for launching a large number of credit based courses at an affordable cost. The programs will also contribute to the visibility and positive perception of SBV at the National level. Ultimately, this sustainable model of FDP can be emulated by others in a competitive environment.

Goals & Outcomes:

- To develop a model of Faculty Development Program (FDP) which is grounded on the principles of Relevance, Quality, Synergy and Sustainability
- To launch series of Faculty development programs by networking and collaborating with experts and knowledge partners in all the four domains of functioning of the faculty, viz., teaching, clinical/patient care, research and administration
- To encourage in-house capacity building by identifying a team of coordinators drawn from the constituent colleges/centres of SBV
- To standardize the planning, organization and evaluation of FDPs (short and long term basis).

Unique Features of SBV Model

- The scope of FDPs is extended to medical, dental, nursing and allied health science education.
- It goes beyond pedagogy and addresses all four major domains of functioning of a health professional – Teaching, Clinical, Research and Administration.
- It addresses all levels of faculty from Postgraduate Residents to junior, mid and senior faculty
- SBV model will draw Resource faculty and work with Knowledge partners within the health profession and beyond. National and International Experts will join seamlessly, on Videoconferencing mode; Some of the national faculty will participate physically. These talks will be supported by hands on experience to the participants provided by the local faculty from SBV, Pondicherry and nearby places.
- The Centre for Health Professions Education which is the nodal agency for national FDPs. CHPE is backed by an International Advisory Board consisting of an eminent panel of experts from South East Asia, Middle East and Western Countries, besides reputed Indian faculty.
- The duration of the workshop will vary from 2 to 3 days preferably on Saturday and Sundays to suit the convenience of participants

Benefits to the Participants

- The workshops are open for wide range of audience: PG Resident doctors, Ph D scholars, Faculty members and administrators
- High quality programs are delivered with inputs from National and International Experts at an affordable cost
- The workshops are slotted during week ends to enable the participants to attend without affecting their normal duties.
- All programs are accredited by SBV and Credit points will be shown in the Certificates
- Access to high quality resource materials at free of cost
- Opportunity Networking with SBV and National/International Knowledge Partners
- For those from far away places, it is a golden opportunity to explore the best of Pondicherry and its tourist attraction

Strategies for Implementation

- The Chief Coordinator for coordinating all FDP workshops is Director, CHPE assisted by the Deputy Director and the Secretariat. He will be responsible for facilitating the Coordinators at various stages of planning, implementation and evaluation. For maintaining uniformity in implementation, guidelines, procedures, protocols and templates will be prepared by the CHPE.
- Each workshop is organized by a team led by a Coordinator who will develop scientific program in consultation with knowledge partners. The process of registration, and logistics are supported by the administration. The organizational structure consists of committees as follows:
- SBV(DU) Steering Committee for National FDP - Vice Chancellor, Deans / Principals/ Vice Principals of all constituent colleges, Directors of Centres, officers of the administration, representatives of management - CEO / GM (Admin) and GM (Finance)
- Advisory Board including eminent health professions educators from India, and abroad. Some of them can also be invited as external Faculty/Resource Persons during the workshops when they are travelling in South.
- Local Coordinators and core groups: This will involve about 20+ groups each led by a Coordinator who will be responsible for planning and implementation of FDPs with support from national faculty and logistics group.
- Logistics Support Group - Budgeting, registration, publicity, program logistics for delegates and resource faculty. This will include staff/officers from Administration (SBV/MGMCRI), Department of IT, Medical Simulation Centre and Central Library. Till such time a dedicated web-site is developed for driving all activities, SBV portal will be utilized. The media and publicity will be assisted by the Public Relations Officer, and SBV - MAPCOM the official media wing of SBV.
- All FDPs will have inbuilt evaluation mechanism for assessing their process, outcome and impact.
- The FDPs will be operated by a separate account "SBVCON" with facility of online payment. All payments registration fees, sponsorship etc will be credited to this account. All expenses will be incurred by following financial procedure of SBV which are subject to audit.

- **Calendar of FDPs**
- The CHPE in consultation with IQAC and the Steering Committee will prepare an annual calendar of FDPs by prioritizing the potential areas of FDPs. A balance needs to be struck in taking up areas of importance laid by the accrediting agencies/regulators and the felt needs of the faculty across the Southern States and Pan-India. The FDP calendar comes in to force with due approval by the Vice Chancellor.
- **Program planning by the Coordinator**
- The Coordinator for each FDP will be responsible for further planning of the event including forming a team, identifying knowledge partners, applying for funding/sponsorship, identifying international/national/local faculty and budgeting the whole activity within the broad guidelines given by the competent authority. All program proposals and budget proposals will be scrutinized by the Director CHPE and put up for approval by the Vice Chancellor.
- **Activities and methods used in the workshop**
- The FDP workshops are a blend of several activities and learning experiences guided by the Resource Persons and Facilitators. They include
 - Presentations by the Speakers (Virtual and Physical)
 - Group Work/Hands On, Case studies
 - Buzz sessions; Think -Pair - Share
 - Brain Storming, Affinity Mapping
 - Panel Discussions and Symposia
 - Quiz, Assignments
 - Pre-test / Post-test
 - Assignments
 - SWOT Analysis
 - Appreciative Inquiry
- All the coordinators will be guided by the procedures, protocols, and checklist developed for the purpose.

Logistics of National Workshops

The workshops will be supplied with logistics support from SBV Administration as follows

Giving publicity through SBV Websites, journals, and Media Publicity Committee (MAPCOM)

Facilitating Payment Gateway for all payments and single bank account for conducting all transactions

Providing and facilitating venues and physical resources for each workshop.

All venues are supported by A/C, projection system, audio-visuals, internet with WIFI to enable video-conference sessions.

Venue Accommodation and transport

The venues of FDPs are located within the cosy campus of SBV. All the venues are well equipped with projection, and internet (WIFI) facilities to enable surfing as well as video-conference sessions.

Considering the availability of good hotels with competitive rates in the city of Pondicherry, the participants are allowed to make their own arrangement of accommodation and local transport to venue, which is away from Pondicherry Airport/Railway Station/Bust Stand (Approx. 17 KMs). The Coordinators of various programs will facilitate the logistics of accommodation and transport.
