**Report of Disciplinary committee meeting held on 11.05.2018**

An Enquiry was conducted on 11.05.2018 as directed by Dean, by the office note NO. MGMCRI/DEAN/Acad/18, dated: 09.05.2018 MGMCRI, consisting of Disciplinary Committee members as below

Prof. Tirou Aroul, (Convenor)  
Prof. Partha Nandi, (Member Secretary)  
Prof. Karthikeyan (Professor and Head of ENT)  
Dr. Swati Jayanti Pawar (Deputy Medical Superintendent)

The enquiry was conducted by calling for Mr. [REDACTED] CRRI, for his unprofessional behavior as mentioned in office note, along with him few more CRRIs, namely, Ms. Nasreen and Ms. Soundarya who were posted with him as co-intern in the same posting on 26.04.2018.

The medical officer of Kirumampakkam was also called over phone, who is directly concerned about the incident.

The following is the narrative of the enquiry findings:-

Mr. [REDACTED] (UIN: [REDACTED]) on being asked, said

He never uttered any word that is threatening in nature towards the Medical Officer of Kirumampakkam PHC. Although, he accepts of often coming late by 15 minutes (even during the posting, in other Health Center) for duties.

He said that he has been marked absent for one day because of his coming late after tea break in the evening by 10 minutes.

He also complaints that he was being called by the name of 'Joker' several times by the medical officer, Dr. Shiva, which he felt was much insulting /humiliating in front of his fellow Junior interns, and due to this he was often getting depressed. But he tells that he is mentally sound now.

While the enquiry was being conducted, he raised his voice once against DMS during interrogation which was totally unprovoked. This observation may reflect his basic nature, attitude or disturbed mental condition.

[REDACTED], a fellow intern (Junior Batch) working along with Mr. [REDACTED] has on one account heard Dr. Shiva calling Mr. [REDACTED] and one other intern as "Joker" while Presentation. The very next day when he was suppose to be in The Systematic Training Programme of the CRRI in the MGMCRI campus, an incident happened in PHC between the M. O. and Mr. [REDACTED] at around 3.30 PM, and there were lot of shouting in the Medical Officer's room and that has made the staffs in the centre to get into the M. O.'s room to separate them from each other to prevent further incident.

[REDACTED] said Dr. Shiva is friendly person otherwise, and he takes time to teach students. He is lenient but occasionally strict.

██████████ one more fellow intern (Junior Batch) narrates the same version as told by Ms. Nasreen. She also added that Mr. ██████████ is a super senior and that is why he felt insulted in front of his juniors. Soundarya also added that Mr. ██████████ is a chronic late comer for duties.

Dr. Shiva, The Medical Officer of Kirumampakkam PHC was called over phone (putting in speaker phone so that all the members in the Committee could listen to the conversation). He narrated the incident in all fairness.

He agreed that while Mr. ██████████ and his friend and colleague were not able to answer simple questions being asked during presentation in PHC, disinterested in the academic sessions, and more over cracking jokes, he admitted to saying, "why are you Joking, this is not a standup comedy show"...

He also added that Mr. ██████████ is having bad attitude towards Professors and other workers and seniors and also has the habit of coming late very often; He is not interested in working or studying, not ready to accept mistakes and improve, etc. The medical officer added Mr. ██████████ has disrespected and threatened him verbally by saying, "I am a local guy, I know how to take care of you outside this P.H.C...etc." said Dr. Shiva, The medical officer of the P.H.C.

### Conclusion:-

Mr. ██████████, who is supposed to be a very senior student, now doing internship in MGMCRI, has been found to be a person with bad attitude and habit of coming late for duties, which does not suit his profession and the demand of profession of being dutiful. He also seems to have behavioral problem which calls for remedial measures.

This incident in the P.H.C came onto surface as it was brought into notice by the M. O., but similar attitudinal and behavioral problem was also report by the medical officers of other PHC, to the H.O.D of community medicine. The written complaint of the H.O.D also clearly mentions the same.

There may be a provocation for the recent incident in the Kirumapakkam PHC because of an unacceptable word "Joker" used for him (and his friends) by the medical officer for the reasons mentioned above...

### Recommendations:-

1. Parents of Mr. ██████████ to be informed regarding the values, attitude and behavior of their ward.
2. Remedial counseling by psychiatric professional and student counselors for adjustment disorder, leading to arrogant behavior and threatening.
3. Duties can be resumed with the clearance from the student and psychiatric counselor.
4. The medical officer to be informed not to use such unacceptable words which may lead to psycho social problem among the CRRIs.

**Sub: Report of the Disciplinary committee meeting held on 20-07-2018**

The following members were present at the meeting-

1. Prof. K. S. Reddy, HOD of Radiation Oncology, Convener
2. Prof. Partha Nandi, Vice Principal (Students), Member Secretary
3. Dr. Lakshmana Perumal, R.M.O.
4. Mr. Balamukundan, Sr. Personnel Manager

After members were appraised regarding the issue at hand it was decided to hear from the PG, CRRIs and other PGs who were present during the altercation.

Dr. [REDACTED], Final M.D. Gen Med) submitted that he was in Medicine Department Library room at around 9.30 pm on 17-07-18 along with another PG Dr. [REDACTED] discussing some presentations. Suddenly three people barged into the room and asked Dr. [REDACTED] to leave the room as they had some issues to deal with Dr. [REDACTED] personally. She had to leave the room reluctantly and went to fetch her other colleagues fearing some altercation. Dr. [REDACTED] identifies two interns Dr. [REDACTED] and Dr. [REDACTED] and the third person was a stranger and not known to him. All three of them apparently used very foul language and abused him, they also pushed him around and Mr. [REDACTED] slapped him at least once. Dr. [REDACTED] has managed to record part of conversation on his cell phone, a copy of which is available with Vice Principal. Meanwhile three PGs from Medicine dept arrived and [REDACTED] left immediately followed in a little while by the other two. Dr. [REDACTED] informed his Chief and apparently based on his advice lodged a complaint with Kirumampakkam police station. He had not visited the emergency department for any check-up.

Dr. [REDACTED] an intern who had recently completed his posting in Medicine dept., presently working in surgery said that he along with his friend Dr. [REDACTED] and a third person accosted Dr. [REDACTED] in Library room. They all persuaded Dr. [REDACTED] to leave as they wanted to discuss a private matter. He was aggrieved by the fact that Dr. [REDACTED] did not like him and has scolded him several times during his posting. He also claims that Dr. Firoz has used bad words against his parents too. He accepts that he used abusive language against Dr. [REDACTED], pushed him around and even slapped him once. He regrets his behavior, has submitted an apology letter. He had called Dr. [REDACTED] and the third person joined them who is apparently not known to him.

Dr. [REDACTED], an intern joined his colleague Dr. [REDACTED] as he called him up to accompany him while he seeks an explanation from Dr. [REDACTED]. He claims that he did not participate in

verbal or physical abuse. He also claims to have separated them when they were holding each other's shirt collars and prevented a fight. He said the third person was met by them in the corridor who joined them. He refused to identify him and did not clearly say if he was his friend. He also says that Dr. [REDACTED] did not include his name in the police complaint as one of the persons who assaulted him.

All Medicine PGs (Dr. [REDACTED], Dr. [REDACTED], Dr. [REDACTED] and Dr. [REDACTED]) were called together. Dr. [REDACTED] was present when the three intruders entered the library and asked her to leave. She had to leave reluctantly as she was scared and brought the other three PGs as soon as she could. She could hear heated exchange of words as she left the room. By the time all four of them reached the library room Dr. [REDACTED] came out of the room and left. The other two also left the scene soon. The third person identified himself as Madhvan before he left but did not give any other details and what he was really doing there. All PGs are worried that this could happen to anybody and they want severe action to be taken against the two interns.

The committee members dwelt on the whole affair and feels that Dr. [REDACTED] is guilty of his action in taking two accomplices along with him and verbally and physically abusing Dr. [REDACTED]. He has also accepted his guilt and apologized. The committee also felt that such pent up anger was the result of Dr. [REDACTED]'s verbal abuse of Dr. [REDACTED] (as perceived by him) during his posting in medicine dept. This could have been avoided by following a decent professional etiquette and good communication skills while dealing with colleagues.

#### **Recommendations:**

As Dr. [REDACTED] has committed a mistake and has also accepted the same in writing may be severely warned and suspended from his internship for a period of Two weeks.

Dr. [REDACTED] was also a party to the whole event but has not indulged in Physical abuse may also be severely warned and suspended for one week of his internship.

Dr. [REDACTED] may be advised to take up such issues with institute authorities and seek redressal rather than going to police.

ORDER OF PUNISHMENT

That you were suspended pending enquiry with effect from 18.07.2018 vide Order No. Dean/Suspension/2018/07-0001 dated 18.07.2018 for alleged grievous misconducts amounting to wrongful confinement, assault and misbehavior amounting to using abusive language and committing acts subversive to discipline, based on the complaint submitted by Dr. [REDACTED], final year M D (General Medicine) and the preliminary investigation conducted on the complaint received.

As per the alleged complaint, you had, accompanied Mr. [REDACTED] .R, (UIN: [REDACTED]), CRRI and one outsider in furtherance common intention and accosted Dr. [REDACTED] final year PG in Department of General Medicine at around 9.30 PM on 17.07.2018 at the General Medicine Department Library after unlawfully confining him within the library and sending out the other inmates who were present and thereafter assisting the misconducts when Mr. [REDACTED] .R assaulted Dr. [REDACTED] physically and used foul and derogatory language against him.

Based on the constitution of an four Member, Disciplinary Committee to go into the charges leveled, an enquiry was held on 20.07.2018, wherein you were provided an opportunity to defend your case with respect to the allegations made against you. During the enquiry you had accepted that you had accompanied Mr. [REDACTED] .R and you were also present when the incident occurred. Though according to your statement you did not assault Dr. [REDACTED], your act of accompanying Mr. [REDACTED] and an unknown person to the General Medicine Department Library is not justified and therefore you are also partly responsible for the occurrence and liable in furtherance to common intention.



The Disciplinary Committee construes that the misconducts are serious nature and as you have also assistant Mr. [REDACTED].R by your presence, the suspension period from 18.07.2018 to 24.07.2018 is confirmed as substantive punishment and you are also severely warned that any such involvement in such matters will entail serious consequences.

Based on the constitution of a four Member, Disciplinary Committee to go into the charges leveled, an enquiry was held on 20.07.2018, wherein you were provided an opportunity to defend your case with respect to the allegations made against you. During the enquiry you had accepted the charges level against you and this also been corroborated by other witnesses.

The Disciplinary Committee has construed that the misconducts are serious in nature and deserves serious punishment and therefore the suspension period from 18.07.2018 to 31.07.2018 is confirmed as substantive punishment and you are also severely warned that any such repetition will entail serious consequences including discontinuation from your studies.





A detailed inquiry was conducted on 1&2 February 2016 by the disciplinary committee members, with the said list of students involved in the said incidence and a written statement also collected individually from these students ,Following is the summary:

The Incident that took place on 09/01/16 appears to have some connection with the incidence that happened earlier at Ceedeeyes campus between 2012 batch students and 2014 batch students as a result of 2014 batch (juniors) students behaving indifferently and not respecting 2012 batch (seniors) students

The incident that took place on 09/01/16 had a beginning with the incidence that happened on 8<sup>th</sup> evening near the play ground [REDACTED] 2015 batch ( Brother of Mr [REDACTED] 2012 batch) was driving the car and went very close to [REDACTED]. This annoyed them and [REDACTED] threw a stick on the car [REDACTED] got down from the car and used bad words at them and this instigated them to hit [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] phoned up to his brother and informed about this to his brother.

On 9<sup>th</sup> forenoon people involved with this incidence were called for enquiry at the college office following that there was a clash between [REDACTED] and Suraj ,Ajith ,Mahaprabhu .The juniors were sent to the mess and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] sent outside the college gate .

Again on 9<sup>th</sup> around 2:15PM [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] came back and group of his friends and batch mates assembled near the road leading to kitchen and attacked [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Sticks ,Cricket stumps, Iron rods and bricks

[REDACTED] (2015 batch) behaviour was the triggering point for the entire incidence

In the present incidence of fight S [REDACTED] ( 2014batch) together have hit [REDACTED]

Reacting for his brother, [REDACTED] along with his friends [REDACTED] , [REDACTED] [REDACTED] , Radha Krishnan , [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (seniors) had planned and attacked the juniors (2014 batch) brutally in the presence of college staff and relatives with vengeance.



On 07th September 2019 (Saturday), I MBBS students were asked to write impositions by the II MBBS Students for a Pathology cycle test question paper (which was given to the II MBBS students by the pathology HoD as a punishment of being absent for the cycle test conducted on 6th september 2019). These assignments were given to the above mentioned I MBBS students and made them to write. The I MBBS students were scared to inform about these incidents either to their mentors or to any of the faculty members thinking that if seniors come to know about this they might harm them.

The I MBBS students were hesitant to give the names of the senior students in writing, as they were worried thinking that it will affect their studies and atmosphere in hostel. Letter from the Principal of KGNC vide communication SBV/ KGNC/ Grievance/2018 dated 21/08/2018

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Based on the findings of the Disciplinary Committee headed by the Principal of Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College (KGNC), the Order of Punishment referred above was issued to eleven students mentioned therein, suspending them for two months from 01.08.2018 to 30.09.2018 by way of punishment for disorderly behavior committed by them at about 12.05 AM on 22.06.2018 in the Treatment Room of the Female Medical Ward (4<sup>th</sup> Floor) of Mahatma Gandhi Medical College Hospital premises.

Subsequent to the issue of the Order of Punishment, a representation was received from [REDACTED] (UIN No: [REDACTED]), B.Sc. Nursing II<sup>nd</sup> year, one of the eleven students, stating that he was not involved in the incident for which the punishment was issued to him. On verification of the video clipping and also in view of the findings of the Enquiry Committee headed by Prof. Sumathy. P, Vice Principal-KGNC, it has become evident that [REDACTED] was not involved in the incident and [REDACTED] of II B.Sc (N) was actually involved and it was a case of mistaken identity. Further [REDACTED] has also submitted his admission letter accepting that he was involved in the incident.
