Interns Orientation Program (IOP)

While internship is a crucial mile stone in medical education, there is a lack of structured approach to the training of interns in most of the medical colleges in India. Realizing the importance of training interns soon after their induction, the Medical Education Unit (MEU) has been conducting a comprehensive training program in two parts. The first part deals with sensitizing the interns regarding the hospital services, their duties and code of conduct. The second part deals with specific issues and skills which are required for ensuring patient safety as well as for enhancing the quality of patient care in a hospital setting. The issues include: How to prevent medical errors, importance of team work, communication skills including verbal and non-verbal communication, rational diagnostics and therapeutics, ethical issues, dealing with pharmaceutical industries and medico-legal issues involved in patient care.

The Part 1 program was held on **31.01.2020**, beginning with a **TED talk on "Doctor's touch"**. This was followed by other issues such as an introduction to CRRI - Policies & Practices, Hospital Policies for Interns, OPD & Wards, PHCs Outreach activities camps, High Dependency Units and Infection Control Policies.

The faculty team consisted of Prof M Ravishankar, Dean, MGMCRI, Prof. Seetesh Ghose, Dr. V. Nirmal Coumare, Dr. Mohamed Hanifah, Dr. C. P. Ganeshbabu, Dr. Jayaramachandran, and Dr. R. Kalaivani.
