Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, a constituent college of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Deemed to be University, Pondicherry had organized an awareness talk on 'Substance abuse - life, Society and Legal implications" on 30th August 2018, between 2.00pm and 4.00 under its auspices for the betterment of the student community drawn from Pondicherry and nearby areas. Dr. V.J. Chandran, IPS, Deputy Inspector General of Police, Government of Puducherry addressed the students on this very important topic especially in the wake of the growing menace of the substance abuse by the students at institutes of higher education. In his speech Dr. Chandran spoke at length on drugs, drug abuse, drug dependence. He explained the students about the common drugs that are being abused by the community at large. He said that the abuse of drugs lead to lots of

deteriorations in physical, psychological well-being. He warned that the trying of drugs in the first attempt will tempt the human being to try more and this is how the addicts are trapped. Also drug abuse leads to Non-co-ordination of physic and mind, loss of decision making, sluggish reaction, blurred vision and memory loss. Earlier in the day Dr. S.C. Parija, Vice-Chancellor of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, presided over the function and said the SBV Policy on drug abuse will be put in public domain and the suggestions from the stake holders will be invited. The Vice-Chancellor initialed a pledge taking by the students on drug abuse which was read by the DIG of Police. The programme is in this direction, the UGC had

directed all the Vice-Chancellors to ensure setting up a mechanism for strict compliance in ensuring a drug free environment in educational institutions across the countries especially








with reference to the rules on tobacco, alcohol, and drugs in all areas within the realms of the University.


Event Name: Essence of healthy body and mind

REPORT

Interns Orientation Program (IOP)

While internship is a crucial mile stone in medical education, there is a lack of structured approach to the training of interns in most of the medical colleges in India. Realizing the importance of training interns soon after their induction, the Medical Education Unit (MEU) has been conducting a comprehensive training program in two parts. The first part deals with sensitizing the interns regarding the hospital services, their duties and code of conduct. The second part deals with specific issues and skills which are required for ensuring patient safety as well as for enhancing the quality of patient care in a hospital setting. The issues include: How to prevent medical errors, importance of team work, communication skills including verbal and non-verbal communication, rational diagnostics and therapeutics, ethical issues, dealing with pharmaceutical industries and medico-legal issues involved in patient care.

The Part 1 program was held on 05.01.2018, beginning with a TED talk on "Doctor's touch". This was followed by other issues such as an introduction to CRRI - Policies & Practices, Hospital Policies for Interns, OPD & Wards, PHCs including camps, High Dependency Units and Infection Control Policies.

The issues include: How to prevent medical errors, importance of team work, communication skills including verbal and non-verbal communication, rational diagnostics and therapeutics, ethical issues, dealing with pharmaceutical industries and medico-legal issues involved in patient care.

The Part 1 of the program was held on 26.07.2018, beginning with a TED talk on "Doctor's touch". This was followed by other issues such as an introduction to CRRI - Policies & Practices, Hospital Policies for Interns, sharing feedback from outgoing interns, OPD & Wards, PHCs Outreach activities camps, High Dependency Units and Infection Control Policies.
