GUEST LECTURE: In the distinguished presence of our honourable Vice Chancellor of SBV Prof. Subhash Chandra Parija, a Guest Lecture titled "TRINITY OF MISSION - Patient care, Research and Education" was delivered by the internationally acclaimed Professor Emeritus Dr. Vedprakash Mishra, a recipient of the prestigious Dr. B. C. Roy National Award and Chancellor, Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed to be University), Pro-Chancellor of Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur on 22nd February 2019, Friday at 2.15 pm. Prof. Vedprakash Mishra in his address stressed that "Mission remains mission if not converted to objectives which is to be achieved through devotion". "Patient care leads to human welfare and patient care is the fore most important trinity among the other two namely, education and research. Health and education are the two parameters to achieve the Welfare State. In the Trinity of Mission, Education is the input, Research is the throughput and Patient Care is the Output. They are interlinked with each other. The output namely, the Patient care should be Quality Centric Education and quality patient care will comprise of Safe patient care, Effective patient care and cost effective health care. Clinical research is gaining its importance but, research on services and research on systems has to be given equal importance for the overall development of our health sector. Prof. Mishra underlined that Faculty Development Programs serve as catalyst for bringing about transformation. However, in order to be more meaningful such programs should essentially address all of the three domains namely, Patient care, Education & Research in a holistic manner.
